Stone Ridge entrance Sign and Fountain – Morning</p> <p>Visuals: LOW ANGLE of fountain and sign, rack focus from fountain to sign</p> <p>Visuals: CUT TO: CU and XCU of water</p> <p>Visuals: TEXT ON SCREEN: “Stone Ridge, Old-Fashioned Living @ Light Speed”</p> <p>Transition: sun spot</p> <p>Actor: jogger</p> <p>Visuals: CG of a long cable ending in a light flash</p>	<p><i>[CUE MUSIC]</i></p> <p>Narrator: Craig Seckler</p> <p>Sounds: birds, cars, ambient, wild sound, sound effects for animation, water</p>
<p><i>Scene 2</i></p> <p>EXT. Woods and Hills - Day</p> <p>Visuals: LOW ANGLE, WS pan wild flowers in foreground</p> <p>Visuals: DISSOLVE TO: WS to MW to MS push into barn</p> <p>Visuals: WS of rolling hills and cows grazing</p>	<p>Narrator: Nestled in the low, rolling hills of historic Loudoun County, Stone Ridge looks like a blueprint of small-town America.</p> <p>Sounds: cows</p>
<p><i>Scene 3</i></p> <p>EXT. Retro Scene on Grassy Field – Day</p> <p>Visuals: XCU of child’s face blowing bubbles</p> <p>Visuals: pull back to reveal 8 or 10 1950’s children (in costume) playing with a hula hoop, throwing a ball, swirling a baton, playing cowboys and Indians. Rack focus, zooms</p> <p>Actors: 8-10 children</p> <p>Props: balls, cowboy outfit, baton, dog, bubbles, hula hoop, Davy Crockett hat, and other clothing</p>	<p>Narrator: An America built on fond memories. Memories of a secure, simpler life. A life centered on family values and neighborhood activities. A life full of joy and the laughter of little children.</p> <p>Sounds: Children laughing, birds singing</p>

<p><i>Scene 4</i> EXT. Community Center – Day Visuals: crane shot, HIGH ANGLE of façade of the Center tilting down to doorway</p>	<p>Narrator: At the heart of Stone Ridge is the warm, inviting Community Center. Here, life-long friendships form and flourish.</p>
<p><i>Scene 5</i> EXT. Community Center – Same Day Visuals: family walking to door</p>	
<p><i>Scene 6</i> INT. Community Center – Front Door – Same Day Visuals: family walking into door</p>	<p>Narrator: Under the direction of our dedicated activities director, weekly events are hosted for your family’s enjoyment.</p>
<p><i>Scene 7</i> INT. Community Center – Front Desk – Same Day Visuals: PUSH IN and TILT UP from front desk with sign “Community Center” to activities director Visuals: tilt to CU of large clock above narrator</p>	<p>Actor Catherine (activities director): Welcome to Stone Ridge.</p>
<p><i>Scene 8</i> INT. Community Center – Community Map – Same Day Visuals: DISSOLVE FROM: clock from clock near the front desk DISSOLVE TO: second clock above the electrified map of the Stone Ridge property</p>	<p>Actor Catherine: (at map) At Stone Ridge you will be able to enjoy... (blah, blah softly about the features of Stone Ridge).</p> <p>Narrator (over actor): The special features of Stone Ridge seem endless with exciting activities, events and group functions for the entire family.</p>
<p><i>Scene 9</i> EXT. Events Lawn – Afternoon Visuals: XLOW, LOW ANGLE shots, through the grass, of three children playing croquet against backdrop of the Community Center Visuals: W and MS of children playing Visuals: CU of multiple hits on one ball Visuals: XCU of red ball through final hoop Actors: three young children Props: croquet set, flowers</p>	<p>Narrator: Croquet anyone? Join a few friends for fun and games on the manicured green of the Events Lawn at Stone Ridge.</p>

<p><i>Scene 10</i> INT. Activities Room – Afternoon – Sun Streaming Visuals: DISSOLVE TO: LOW ANGLE, FISH EYE then MS, EYE LEVEL of round table with bunches of balloons tied to the back chair Visuals: children around the table singing and blowing noise makers Visuals: push in on birthday girl at head of table blowing out candles on a birthday cake Actors: girl and five extras Props: birthday cake, party hats, noise makers, plates, forks and cups, table and chairs</p>	<p>Narrator: Take a class, join a club or throw a surprise birthday party for that special boy or girl in our members-only activity center.</p> <p>Sounds: Noise makers Sounds: Children laughing and clapping, and singing, <i>Happy Birthday</i></p>
<p><i>Scene 11</i> INT. Library – Late Afternoon Visuals: MS dolly past library, black divider, second room Visuals: MS, MS of mother taking a book from shelves, sitting with child as they look through the book Visuals: a mother and small child Props: books</p>	<p>Narrator: Introduce your children to the pleasures of reading in the quiet of our community center’s lending library. Soon, a new, regional county library will open right here at Stone Ridge.</p>
<p><i>Scene 12</i> INT. Cafe – Late Morning Visuals: WS, dolly MS, TWO-SHOT of friends chatting, laughing and drinking coffee at the café counter Actors: two principals, male and female Props: coffee cups, wireless laptop</p>	<p>Narrator: Then meet your friends at the Cyber Café for coffee and conversation.</p>
<p><i>Scene 13</i> INT. Fitness Center – Day Visuals: MS dolly through the glass of the gym to outside glass. CU of model camera right. Push in on four then two people working out on step-climber machines Visuals: CU on toned bodies Actors: four adults on exercise machines Props: exercise outfits, towels</p>	<p>Narrator: Or <i>step up</i> to a healthier you in the state-of-the-art Fitness Center at Stone Ridge. You’ll love the results.</p> <p>Sounds: Exercise equipment</p>

<p><i>Scene 14</i> INT. Theatre – Anytime Visuals: CU of child’s head through popcorn machine with corn popping. CU of child accepting bag of popcorn Visuals: MS camera pushes in to CU, TILT UP and LEFT on poster of <i>The Wizard of Oz and Judy Garland</i> Visuals: WS of theatre Visuals: Children watching movie and clapping Actors: 10 children and one adult Props: Popcorn machine, popcorn popping, bag of popcorn, retro poster</p>	<p>Narrator: Grab a bag of popcorn and a seat and check out a popular current release, or perhaps a beloved movie classic in our spacious theatre. Sound Track: Wizard of Oz, kids clapping</p>
<p><i>Scene 15</i> EXT. Shopping – Afternoon Visuals: PAN left and right, PUSH IN on shopping center</p>	<p>Narrator: Shop ‘til you drop at the Stone Ridge Village Center. Grab your weekly groceries at the Harris Teeter Supermarket. Visit a medical office for the kids’ annual checkup. Open a new college savings account at Bank of America. Then take time for a quick cappuccino, or a relaxing restaurant meal.</p>
<p><i>Scene 16</i> EXT. Swimming Pool – Retro and Present Time – Afternoon Visuals: Retro WS and MS of beautiful 50’s woman in retro swimsuit sitting on the side of the pool Visuals: morph of retro woman into current woman in modern swimsuit sitting on side of pool with her feet in pool Visuals: FISHEYE of pool Visuals: children jump into the pool and swim to woman Actor: woman, Hilary, 20 extras Props: bathing suits, scarf, sunglasses, towels and other swimming apparel.</p>	<p>Narrator: Remember sitting around the pool just to be <i>seen</i>? Now be seen with all your friends and family at our contemporary swimming pool and rejuvenating spa. Jump in...the water’s divine.</p>
<p><i>Scene 17</i> EXT. Swimming Pool – Cocktail Party – Early Evening Visuals: WS of couple, party under a dark blue sky with rolling clouds Visuals: CU of couple sitting at the pool’s edge Visuals: OVERHEAD SHOT, WS of couples dancing and laughing raising cocktail glasses</p>	<p>Narrator: Raise your glass and enjoy an elegant poolside party under a starry Stone Ridge sky.</p>

<p><i>Scene 18</i> EXT. Swimming Pool – Cocktail Party – Pool’s Edge Visuals: MW to MS of one couple sitting with feet in the water Visuals: CU of a kiss Visuals: TILT UP toward to party. MS and CU of party goers with kissing couple at bottom of the frame, CU of glasses, smiling faces Actors: six males and six females Props: glasses, martinis, Chinese lanterns, pool candles, table, chairs</p>	<p>Narrator: You’ll fall in love all over again. SOUND: Dance music, laughter, glasses clinking, water splashing.</p>
<p><i>Scene 19</i> EXT. Amphitheatre – Late Afternoon to Early Evening with royal blue sky and dark, moving clouds Visuals: WS of audience and band concert on stage Visuals: MS LOW ANGLE, then WS from bottom of stage to performers Actors: 3 or 4 dozens adults and children as audience Actors: two dozen children dancing in front of band Visuals: seven-piece band Props: smoke</p>	<p>Narrator: The curtain goes up at the amphitheater with theatrical performances, storytelling, dance recitals and lively summer concerts...all for your family’s enjoyment. Bravo! SOUNDS: Band music, clapping, people talking, kids laughing.</p>
<p><i>Scene 20</i> EXT. Van Metre Model Home – Morning – Retro Visuals: CUT TO crane shot, HIGH ANGLE to MS of boy playing with his dog in a field, ready to throw stick Visuals: TRANSITION SHOT of stick flying through air</p>	<p>Narrator: Van Metre homes are all about warm relationships and lifestyle. A lifestyle built on character, comfort, convenience and community.</p>
<p><i>Scene 21</i> EXT. Sidewalk Outside Model Home – Morning – Retro Visuals: TRANSITION SHOT, DOLLY SHOT from moving stick to child’s moving feet Visuals: MS to WS of child on old-fashioned roller skates Actor: young girl Props: old skates, 50’s clothing</p>	<p>Narrator: Van Metre, building trust with quality housing and beautiful communities. Since the 1950’s, more than 50,000 families have “<i>come home</i>” to Van Metre.</p>

Sidewalk Outside Model Home – Same Day – Present Day Visuals: CU and MS, DOLLY SHOT of retro child morphs into present day child on inline skates, knee pads, helmet Actor: Child on roller skates then inline skates</p>	<p>Narrator: Stone Ridge...built on the lifestyle you remember...only better. Sounds: Roller skates, birds</p>

<p><i>Scene 23</i> EXT. Van Metre Home – Balcony – Afternoon Visuals: OVERHEAD WS from second story balcony, actor walks through the door of her home Actor: girl, Sophie</p>	
<p><i>Scene 24</i> INT. Van Metre Home – Foyer – Same Day Visuals: OVERHEAD WS from second story staircase, actor walks through the front door of her home Actor: girl, Sophie.</p>	<p>Actor Sophie: Hi, Mom, I’m home.</p>
<p><i>Scene 25</i> INT. Van Metre Home – Kitchen – Same Day Visuals: DOLLY SHOT, FISHEYE and WS with mother cooking in beautiful kitchen, child moves toward cooking island and takes a seat. Mother serves her a taste of sauce Actor: girl, Sophie. Props: kitchen accessories</p>	<p>Narrator: We cordially invite you to join our growing family of homeowners. Homeowners who share your interests and your passions. Homeowners who soon will become your valued friends and extended family.</p>
<p><i>Scene 26</i> EXT. Stone Ridge Campus – Afternoon Visuals: Aerial view of property Visuals: CRANE SHOT of property with Community Center at the center of the shot</p>	<p>Narrator: Stone Ridge... reminding you of the safety and certainty of earlier days. So, raise your expectations and your standard of living. Move up to a more fashionable, more secure life for your whole family. Move up to Stone Ridge.</p>
